



### **About Us:**

The Youth Junction Inc. in 2005 secured the last remaining building of the H.V McKay Harvester Factory site in Sunshine. The 'bulk store' was refurbished and revistalised to create the Visy Cares Hub which is a co-located, one stop shop. The Hub comprises of 12 essential and well networked not-for-profit youth services with 20programs that respond to the needs of disadvantaged young people aged between 12-25years.

The Youth Junction Inc. has three primary roles within the community as project lead of the Visy Cares Hub, facilitator of collaborative practice across youth services and designer and developer of youth specific programs.

### Mission:

The Youth Junction Inc. creates opportunities for young people to build resilience and enable them to make a positive contribution to society.

## **Programs:**

NW-YLP (North West Youth Learning Pathways Program) - Education, employment and training program for young people aged between 17-25 years. Consortium of organisations including The Youth Junction Inc. as lead, Youth Now, Centre for Multi-Cultural Youth and Melton City Council.

# Programs:

Y.C.L.P (Youth Community & Law Program) - participants of the program are aged between 18-25 years who have been referred directly by the magistrates court to receive support and interventions from The Youth Junction Inc.

## Programs:

P.A.R.T.Y (Prevent Alcohol and Risk-Related Trauma in Youth) - a group program for up to 45 young people aged between 18-25 years involved in the criminal justice system. Provides the opportunity to participate in workshops involving Victoria Police, Royal Melbourne Hospital and Judy Lazarus Transition Centre.

## Programs:

Y.U.P (Youth Umbrella Project) - Crime prevention partnership project lead by The Youth Junction Inc. and involving a diverse range of partner providers. The program operates under a case management framework and focuses on early intervention and prevention of at risk and criminal activity.
