The Youth Junction Inc. programs and areas of focus include:

YOUTH COMMUNITY & LAW PROGRAM

Works with young people from a diverse range of cultural backgrounds mostly living in the Western suburbs of Melbourne. Referrals are received from magistrates court.

NW-YLP

Funded by the Department of Education & Training to the North-West consortium of organisations including TYJInc. YouthNow, Centre for Multicultural Youth and Melton City Council to address risk-taking and offending behaviour of young people aged 17-25 years, by implementing protective factors relating to education, employment and training across Melton, Wyndham and Brimbank.

Y.U.P (YOUTH UMBRELLA PROJECT)

The program addresses recidivism and offending behaviour of young people aged 12-24 years who have had contact with, or have a demonstrated risk of becoming involved in the criminal justice system.

P.A.R.T.Y (Prevent Alcohol and Risk-related Trauma in Youth)

Pre-sentence program developed in 2010 for young adults aged 18-25 years who have been referred by the Sunshine and Werribee Magistrates Court and is provided by TYJInc. in partnership with Magistrates Court of Sunshine, Werribee & Broadmeadows, Royal Melbourne Hospital and VicPol over 3-days including a pre-PARTY session, full day workshop at Royal Melbourne Hospital and post-PARTY session to prepare reports for court.
